RE: RESPONSE TO GRAND JURY REPORT – THE ORANGE COUNTY ANIMAL SHELTER: THE FACILITY, THE FUNCTION, THE FUTURE

Dear Judge Sanders:

This letter constitutes, in accordance with Section 933.05 of the California Penal Code, the response of the City of Huntington Beach (City) to the Orange County Grand Jury 2014-2015 Report, titled "The Orange County Animal Shelter: the Facility, the Function, the Future" (Grand Jury Report). As required, the City of Huntington Beach is responding to Recommendation 4.

Grand Jury Recommendations

The City of Huntington Beach is providing the following response to the required recommendation, in accordance with California Penal Code Sections 933 and 933.05 (a) and (b).

Recommendation

R-4 The 19 contracting cities need to review their long-term commitment to be part of Orange County Animal Care as opposed to pursuing animal-care opportunities on their own or join in with neighboring cities that have shelters. The contracting cities need to demand that the County provide them with a viable plan with cost and schedule estimates for new facility or facilities to evaluate as part of their commitment review.

The recommendation has not yet been implemented, but will be implemented in the future. As a contracting City, the City of Huntington Beach will request from Orange County Animal Care a base plan with cost and schedule estimates for a new facility at the former Tustin Air Station.
