## Dear Judge Dunning:

On behalf of the City of Laguna Beach, I am responding to the Orange County Grand Jury report entitled "Paper Water." We were asked to respond to the findings F.1, F.2 and R.1.

<u>F.1</u> – We disagree that there is inadequate coordination, at least as far as the City of Laguna Beach and Laguna Beach County Water District are concerned. The City Council serves as the Board of Directors for the Laguna Beach County Water District. The water supply plans are based upon the City's General Plan to ensure adequate coordination. In addition, Laguna Beach is about 99% built out, so the issue of water supplies for future growth is not a significant issue in our community.

<u>F.2</u> – While this may have been a true statement a year ago, we disagree that it is accurate today. In fact, the water crisis has a great deal of public attention at this point. Serving as the Board of Directors in the Laguna Beach County Water District, the City Council recently enacted a program to reduce water usage in our community. Previously, the City has enacted code sections that require drought tolerant native landscaping in all new construction. The Laguna Beach County Water District is also involved in the possible desalinization plan in South Orange County which illustrates the recognition of a very serious problem.

<u>R.1</u> – As indicated previously, there is very little additional growth planned in Laguna Beach. Our General Plan reflects all of the mandated elements as required by the State. While the concept of a water element may be important to growing communities in Orange County, we do not believe it is essential or necessary in Laguna Beach given the close cooperation between the Water District and the City.
