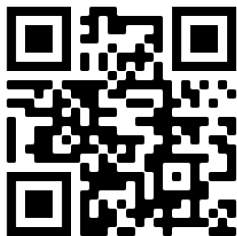

The role of a Grand Jury differs substantially from a trial jury. It is a fulltime assignment. Approximately 80% of time is spent in a civil watchdog role with remaining time spent in criminal indictment hearings. No jury trials and all proceedings are closed to the public.

## 2023-2024 ORANGE COUNTY GRAND JURY Recruitment and Selection Timeline

- 9/16/2022** **Early Application Period** – Information and application form will be available online, [www.ocgrandjury.org](http://www.ocgrandjury.org), or by calling the Grand Jury Hotline, 657-622-6747.
- 1/16/2023** **Application Deadline**
- 1/23/2023** **Letter mailed to all applicants** regarding Applicant Orientation meeting.
- 2/3/2023** **Applicant Orientation** – 2:00-3:00 p.m., informational session with participants from the Court, O.C. Sheriff's Department, and Grand Jury at the Central Justice Center, Department C1, 700 W. Civic Center Dr., Santa Ana 92701.
- 2/3-2/27/2023** Judges of the Grand Jury Recruitment and Selection Committee review applications and select no more than 90 applicants, proportionately distributed from the five O.C. Supervisorial Districts.
- 3/6/2023** Jury Commissioner confirms selected candidates and informs all applicants by mail.
- 3/6 - 4/3/2023** O.C. Sheriff's Department conducts no more than 90 background investigations.
- 4/10-4/21/2023** Grand Jury Recruitment and Selection Committee members conduct interviews.
- 4/24 - 4/28/2023** Grand Jury Recruitment and Selection Committee members select 25-30 candidates to proportionately represent the five O.C. Supervisorial Districts.
- 5/1/2023** Grand Jury Recruitment and Selection Committee votes to confirm slate of 25-30 candidates to proportionately represent the five O.C. Supervisorial Districts.
- 5/3 - 5/10/2023** Superior Court judges vote to approve the final slate of 25-30 Grand Jury nominees (majority approval required).
- 5/13/2023** Names of the 25-30 candidates to be published and all candidates notified by mail.
- 5/10- 5/19/2023** **Candidates Fingerprinted** – O.C. Sheriff's Department, Live Scan Office, 320 N. Flower St., Santa Ana 92703.
- 5/19/2023** **Drawing to Designate 19 Grand Jury Members and Alternates** – 11:00 a.m.-12:00 noon, at the Central Justice Center, Department C1, 700 W. Civic Center Dr., Santa Ana 92701.
- 5/23/2023** Deadline for **Grand Jury Members** to apply to be foreperson, 4:00 p.m.
- 5/25/2023** Judges interview foreperson candidates.
- 5/26/2023** Name of Grand Jury foreperson is announced.
- 6/13, 6/14, 6/15, & 6/16/2023** **Mandatory Training** – 19 grand jurors and all alternates attend orientation and training conducted by members of the outgoing Grand Jury and their advisors.
- 6/30/2023** **Oath of Office Ceremony** – 10:00-11:00 a.m., at the Central Justice Center, Department C1, 700 W. Civic Center Dr., Santa Ana 92701.
